At the American Swedish Historical Museum**



**Philadelphia, PA-** The American Swedish Historical Museum and Auxiliary Club invite you for a fun and educational day to celebrate the relationship between the Lenape Native Americans and the New Sweden settlers. Come and enjoy cultural workshops including wood working, basket weaving, bead and leather work, as well as traditional dance demonstrations. Presenters include Uri Ridgeway, Bob Baker, Mary and Steve Carty, and Tim Wills, to name a few.

There will also be craft activities for children, including pinch pot making, bead making, and face painting, as well as a Lenape language scavenger hunt. Food and refreshments will also be for sale.

Admission is \$10 for non-members, \$7 for members (adult), \$4 for seniors and children. Pay at the door.

The American Swedish Historical Museum is located in FDR Park at 1900 Pattison Avenue in South Philadelphia, five blocks west of the Sports Complex. The Museum is easily accessible from Route 95 or 76 and has free parking. For those taking public transportation, the Broad Street subway AT&T/Pattison Ave stop, or SEPTA's Route 17 bus is within walking distance of the Museum.
