**First ever powwow at the museum with
Drums Along the Delaware
At the American Swedish Historical Museum
Saturday, September 28, 9am-5pm**

Philadelphia, PA- If you have ever wanted to experience an authentic Native American powwow, now is your chance! Join the ASHM and our Auxiliary Club as we host the "Drums Along the Delaware Powwow" on Saturday, September 28th from 9am to 5pm on the museum grounds. It will feature a variety of Native American performers, including drum and flute players, including colorful performances featuring the Southern Drum "Red Blanket Singers" and the Northern Drum "Medicine Horse Singers," as well as chicken and hoop dancers.

The event will also have Native craft and food vendors, along with an Auxiliary food stand. Admission is \$10 for a family of 4, \$5 for adults, \$3 for people under 18, seniors and ASHM members, free for children under 12. Fee also includes free admission to the museum with free parking just outside. Pay at the door.

2013 has been a yearlong celebration of the 375th anniversary of the New Sweden Colony and the first European settlement of the Delaware Valley. The powwow is another part of those celebrations, honoring the Lenape people of the Delaware Valley, who were very much a part of the life of the New Sweden Colony.
