Each Toddler Time class includes circle time, stories, and activities that encourage creative self-expression and promote motor skill development. Join us as we travel

through the museum and through the year while focusing on the wonders of weather, what animals do during different seasons, colorful holidays in Sweden and much more. This will truly inspire your child's imagination! Toddler Time classes begins January 15th, 2013 and occur on the third Tuesday of the month.
