Vendor Event Guidelines

1. Set up 8:00 am-11:30 am on Sunday Oct. 13, 2019. Must be ready by 12 - Event start time.
2. Vendor tables and merchandise must be broken down by 7 pm
3. Items for sale must represent the upcycle event theme.
4. Please note that the event will be held in a large outdoor events tent. In case of extreme inclement weather, it may be moved inside the museum.
5. There is very limited wifi access outside the museum building. Please don't plan on relying on it for cc sales. Individual data networks are recommended.
